Allegation: Black mold and mushrooms have been observed in the school age room.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: The direct egress door frame in the school age room is leaking, moisture was observed and staff reported seeing mold and mushrooms growing . A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Submit the program's corrective action plan which includes a statement that the leak has been repaired and is no longer causing moisture to collect around the floorboard and door frame.
