Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was stored on a low shelf in an unlocked closet in the Preschool 3 classroom where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 1,2 below.

- 1. Bleach.
- 2. Cleaning agent.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.

- 6. Poison, including insect/rodent poison.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the Infant 3 group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number(s) 6 below, as required in rule:

- 1. Upon arrival;
- 2. After toileting/diaper change;
- 3. After contact with bodily fluids;
- 4. After returning from outdoor play;
- 5. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity;
- 6. Before eating or assisting with food preparation;
- 7. After water activities;
- 8. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water);

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

Code: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the small, portable Little Tykes slide climber was positioned such that the fall zone for number 9 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone did not extend six feet from the point of furthest extension;
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from fence;
- 3. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment (large climber);
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment;
- 5. Other [].

The program is required to provide equipment that is safe with adequate fall zones. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain documentation from a licensed physician if a child over 24 months of age is to be served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no documentation from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner as required by the rule, when children over 24 months of age were served anything other than one percent or skim milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified. The Toddler 3 group was given Vitamin D milk. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Code: The program is required to complete fire drills, weather drills, and emergency/lockdown drills

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item number(s) 3 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other: assigned group.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to include all information.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number(s) 4.

- 1. Date of examination;
- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the appropriate form and retain current documentation to administer medications. The program is also required to obtain separate documentation for each medication and child, and retain on file each JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" for at least one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number(s) 8 below:

- 1. The JFS 01217 was missing or incomplete for a topical product, food supplement, medical food.
- 2. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.
- 3. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.
- 4. The time period to administer the medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication.
- 6. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.
- 7. The JFS 01217 was not on file for one year.



8. The prescription label was not current .
