Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-19 Supervision

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to supervise children in their assigned group by sight and hearing. Supervision includes being near enough to respond and reach children immediately including responding to the child's basic needs and protecting them from harm.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not being properly supervised as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during indoor play.
- 2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.
- 3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.
- 4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.
- 5. Other: [].

Children must be supervised according to rule and within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 3 below, were in the children's restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.

- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to clean equipment throughout the day if dirty or soiled.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was unclean or soiled during daily use; chairs in infant room and high chair straps. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and sanitizing as noted in number 6 below:

- 1. The material had a tear;
- 2. The material was not washable;
- 3. The material was porous;
- 4. The surface was cracked;
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning and sanitizing;
- 6. The material was peeling off the mat.

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and shall be kept clean and in good repair. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all staff wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one staff member with the infant group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 7 below, as required in rule:

- Upon arrival for the day;
- 2. After breaks;
- 3. Upon returning from outside;
- 4. After toileting or assisting a child with toileting;
- 5. After each diaper change or pull-up change;
- 6. After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids;
- 7. After cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products;
- 8. After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet;
- 9. Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child;
- 10. Before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication;
- 11. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water);
- 12. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that while there was adequate fall surface material in the outdoor play space, proper distribution had not been maintained under and around equipment as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that fall surface material has been properly redistributed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

Code: The program is required to post the currently menu for the week.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the current snack menu for this week was not posted. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

Code: The program is required to include two food groups when serving a snack.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that snacks served at the program did not include foods from two of the four food groups. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed,

please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

Code: The program is required to provide meals and snacks as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not provide the following required meal(s) and/or snack(s) for the program's hours of operation, as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. One meal and one snack.
- 2. One meal and two snacks or two meals and one snack.
- 3. Breakfast, two meals and two snacks.
- 4. One snack.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to refrain from heating bottles in a microwave.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles were heated in the microwave. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that completed medical examination statement(s) for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
