**Rule:** 5101:2-12-03 Inspection Requirements

**Code:** The program is required to respond to noncompliances by the date noted in the inspection report.

**Finding:** During the inspection, it was determined the program had not responded to the non-compliances addressed in the inspection report dated 12/8/2021. The rule requires the program to complete and submit a corrective action plan in OCLQS to address non-compliances detailed in written inspection reports within the timeframe outlined in the report. **Rule:** 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

**Code:** The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

**Finding:** During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 5 below:

1. There was no method in place;
2. The method did not include each child's name;
3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group. The arrival and departure was completed earlier in the day, not as children arrived and departed.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

**Rule:** 5101:2-12-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan



Code: The program is required to have the JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" posted in a readily available area at the program.

Finding: During the inspection it was determined that the JFS 01201 "Dental First Aid" was not posted in a location readily available to center staff and parents as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/30/2022

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

Code: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that a fall zone hazard a tripping hazard was present, in that, the underlayment was up in several areas and posed a risk of injury if a child were to fall from a piece of equipment. The program is required to provide fall zones that are free of hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Indoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to serve children in areas that are exclusively used for child care during the program's operating hours.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that areas included in the program's measured space were not used exclusively for child care during the program's hours of operation, as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Daily Outdoor Play

Code: The program is required to provide indoor gross motor activities for all children.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that indoor gross motor activities were not provided for the preschool group(s) as required, when the weather was not suitable for outdoor play. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/30/2022

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Indoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to serve children in areas that are exclusively used for child care during the program's operating hours and will have the licensing capacity redetermined based on use.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have exclusive use of the measured space during the program's hours of operation. As a result, the program's license capacity will need to be re-determined to reflect the space currently available. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 05 Health & Safety**

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Management of Communicable Disease

Code: The program is required to post the JFS 08087 "Ohio Communicable Disease Chart".

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the JFS 08087 "Ohio Communicable Disease Chart" was not posted as required, as indicated in number 3 below:

1. The chart was not posted.
2. In a location readily available to program staff and parents.
3. The posted chart was not the current version.
4. The posted chart was not displayed in the size available in the ODJFS forms central to be easily read.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

Code: The program staff medicals are required to include all information.

Finding: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in numbers 1 and 2.

1. Date of examination;
2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
  - a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
  - b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
  - c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test
  - a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
  - b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
  - c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
  - d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Qualifications

Code: The program administrator is required to complete the rules course review within the defined time period.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the administrator had not completed the required rules review course provided by this Department for program administrators within the time period defined in this



rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/30/2022

**Domain: 09 Children's Files**

**Rule:** 5101:2-12-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

**Code:** The program is required to have a completed medical on file at the program for each child enrolled.

**Finding:** In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in numbers 1, 2, and 8 below:

1. No medical was on file for at least one child
2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
5. The date of the exam was more than 13 months prior to the date the form was signed.
6. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
7. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
8. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
10. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions

**Rule:** 5101:2-12-16 Written Disaster Plan

**Code:** The program is required to have a written disaster plan.

**Finding:** During the inspection, it was determined the program's written disaster plan did not meet the requirement or was missing the information in numbers 5, 6, 7, 13, 14, 15, 17, 18, 19, and 20 below:

Procedures:

1. The written disaster plan had not been completed
2. The plan was not provided to all child care staff and employees
3. The plan was not used to respond to an emergency or disaster situation
4. Weather emergencies and natural disasters which include severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, flash flooding, major snowfall, blizzards, ice storms or earthquakes





5. Emergency outdoor and indoor lockdown or evacuation due to threats of violence which includes active shooter, bioterrorism or terrorism
  6. Emergency or disaster evacuations due to hazardous materials and spills, gas leaks or bomb threats.
  7. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
  8. Loss of power, water, or heat
  9. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program

10. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be reunited with the parent
  11. Assisting infants and children with special needs and/or health conditions
  12. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
  13. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated
  14. Procedures for communicating with parents during loss of communications, no phone or internet service available
  15. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to shelter in place
  16. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip
  17. Making the plan available to all child care staff members and employees
  18. Training of staff or reassignment of staff duties as appropriate
  19. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
  20. Contact with local emergency management officials

1. Child care staff members and employees were not trained annually.
2. Written documentation of the training was not kept on file.
