<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 6,7,10,11 below:

- 1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use.
- 2. Reusable cloths were not being cleaned daily or when visibly soiled.
- 3. Dividers were not cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep.
- 5. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized between preparing raw and cooked food.
- 6. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized (toddlers & Pre-K).
- 7. The sinks were not clean (Toddler).
- 8. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized.
- 9. Potty chairs were not emptied and/or cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 10. Wastebaskets/trash receptacles/rinse buckets were not being cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled (Toddler & Pre-K).
- 11. Other: bathroom stool & light switches in the Pre-K room).

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

- 5. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
- 6. Location of children's records was not complete.
- 7. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
- 8. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
- 9. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [ ].
