Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Finding: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item, condition or equipment noted in number(s) 15 below:

1. Closed ended pull cord(s) on the window blind(s)
2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.

16. Large or heavy pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training.
