Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" for a child with a health condition.



<u>Finding</u>: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms or a medical procedure be performed at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. No plan was on file (for asthma, a pineapple juice allergy & a watermelon allergy).

- 15. Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 16. Directions regarding additional services, if applicable, were missing.
- 17. Dated signature of parent giving permission to perform the procedure was missing.
- 18. Dated signature of program administrator was missing.
- 19. The plan was not implemented.
- 20. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 21. The plan was not followed.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that child care staff did not meet the basic needs of a child as noted in number(s) 5,6 below:

- 1. Assisting children with toileting;
- 2. Assisting children with hand washing;
- 3. Assisting children with basic hygiene;
- 4. Responding appropriately to a child in distress;
- 5. Assisting a child wiping his/her nose;
- 6. Washing a child's face;
- 7. Assisting a child in tying his/her shoes;
- 8. Assisting a child in changing his/her clothes when needed.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint Infants, Small Toddlers, Toddler 2 & Preschool 1). <u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the daily program schedule was not posted in the Small Toddler area as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the portable climber (house with slide & small slide) were positioned such that the fall zone for number 1 & 3 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone did not extend six feet from the point of furthest extension;
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from fence;
- 3. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment;
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment;

5. Other [ ].

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an infant who was 12 months or older was assigned to a cot without written permission from the parent, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation



## <u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing breast milk/formula for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance.
