Code: The program staff is required to follow the practices preferred by the parents.

Allegation: Allegedly an infant was not fed while in care at the program, in that, when an infant was picked up they still had all full bottles from drop off.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the feeding practices used by child care staff members were not in accordance with parental preferences, in that an infant was not fed throughout the day. At pick up time the infant had not been fed the bottles left at drop off. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is required at this time.
