Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in the toddler room bathroom and preschool bathroom (Men's) where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 1 and 9 below.

- 1. Bleach wipes.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material in the Toddler room at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. The material had a tear.
- 2. The material was not washable.
- 3. The material was porous.
- 4. The surface was cracked.
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in number 11 below:

- 1. There was rust exposed;
- 2. There was protruding bolts;
- 3. There were cracks;
- 4. There were holes;
- 5. There was splintering wood;
- 6. There were sharp edges or points;
- 7. There were lead hazards;
- 8. There were toxic substances;
