Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment
Code: The program is required to anchor equipment to the ground as required, to close "S" hooks to prevent the chain from slipping off and prevent strangulation and provide equipment with openings that will not pose a safety risk.

Finding: "During the inspection, it was determined that equipment on the outdoor play space posed an imminent risk of harm to a child as noted in number(s) 7 below:

1. The climber was not anchored.
2. The swings were not securely anchored.
3. The slide was not securely anchored.
4. The climbing rope was not securely anchored at both ends.
5. The "S" hooks on the climber were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.
6. The "S" hooks on the swing(s) were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.



7. The new ladder on the climber had an opening (second opening from the top) that was greater than three and one-half inches, but less than nine inches. Equipment openings must be less than 3 1/2 inches or more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment.

Discontinue the use of this equipment until it has been removed, repaired or replaced. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule."

Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-12-2.2 Transitional Pandemic Requirements

Code: The program is required to ensure all administrators, employees, child care staff members and school-age children wear a face covering while indoors, unless not medically or developmentally appropriate.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not follow the requirements for wearing face coverings as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. At least one administrator, child care staff member or employee did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering (face shields are not acceptable face coverings).
2. At least one school-age child did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically and developmentally appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering.
3. At least one individual's face covering did not cover their nose and mouth.
4. At least one child under two years old wore a face covering.

Rule: 5101:2-12-2.2 Transitional Pandemic Requirements



Code: The program is required to ensure safe health practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not follow the requirements for ensuring safe practices to prevent the spread of COVID-19 as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. At least one administrator, employee, child care staff member or child was not assessed for the symptoms listed in appendix A to this rule prior to, or as soon as they arrived each day.
2. The program did not immediately send home a child, administrator, child care staff member or employee who had a temperature of one hundred degrees or higher.
3. The program did not immediately send home a child, administrator, child care staff member or employee who had at least one symptom listed in appendix A to this rule and has had known contact with someone confirmed or probably to have COVID-19.
4. An individual was allowed to return to the center prior to being fever free without the use of fever-reducing medication for at least twenty-four hours.
5. An individual who had a temperature of one hundred degrees or higher, or had at least one symptom listed in appendix A to this rule, and had known contact with someone confirmed or probable to have COVID-19 did not complete isolation or quarantine procedures for COVID-19 in coordination with the local health department prior to returning to the center.

Code: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 3, 4 below:

1. There was no method in place;
2. The method did not include each child's name;
3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Code: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 4 below, were in the two restrooms on the first floor:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet paper.
3. There were no paper towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.

Code: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

6. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department, hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency, and police department were not complete.
7. Location of children's records was not complete.
8. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
9. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
10. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [].
