Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for the infant group.

The ratio determined for the infant group was 2 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 16 children.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff Member.
