Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the center did not provide nap and rest time in accordance with the developmental needs of each child. Upon arrival it was observed that children from the groups Toddler through School Age were on cots. Scheduled posted in the Toddler Classroom said there is a rest period from 6-730 am. Children were observed on cots until approximately 9:30 am. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
