Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans
Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" for a child with a health condition.

Finding: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms or a medical procedure be performed at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number(s) 6 & 9 below:

1. No plan was on file.
2. Child's name was missing.
3. Child's date of birth was missing.
4. Name of the condition was missing.



5. Symptoms to watch for were missing.
6. Action to be taken if symptoms to occur were missing.
7. Activities/foods/environmental conditions to avoid, if applicable, were missing.
8. Medical procedures to be followed were missing.
9. Expected benefit was missing.
10. Name of any applicable medication was missing.
11. Medication listed in the procedures to follow was not onsite available to administer as instructed and alternate instructions for this situation were not included on the plan.
12. Instructions regarding emergency evacuation, if applicable, were missing.
13. Training instructions were missing.
14. Dated signature of parent or certified professional who trained the program staff was missing.
15. Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
16. Directions regarding additional services, if applicable, were missing.
17. Dated signature of parent giving permission to perform the procedure was missing.
18. Dated signature of program administrator was missing.
19. The plan was not implemented.
20. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
21. The plan was not followed.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

Code: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 5 below:

1. There was no method in place;
2. The method did not include each child's name;
3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all staff wash their hands as outlined in rule.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one staff member with the Toddler 1 group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 6 (after wiping a child's nose) below, as required in rule:

1. Upon arrival for the day;
2. After breaks;
3. Upon returning from outside;
4. After toileting or assisting a child with toileting;
5. After each diaper change or pull-up change;
6. After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids;
7. After cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products;
8. After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet;
9. Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child;
10. Before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication;
11. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water);
12. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements

Code: The program is required to have all children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the Infant 1 group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 2 (after diapering) below, as required in rule:

1. Upon arrival;



2. After toileting/diaper change;
3. After contact with bodily fluids;
4. After returning from outdoor play;
5. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity;
6. Before eating or assisting with food preparation;
7. After water activities;
8. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water);
9. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program:

- The changing pad in the toddler room was torn, preventing appropriate sanitation.
- Several toy shelves were dirty.

A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Finding: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 below:



1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
2. Telephone cords.
3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
4. Stacked chairs.
5. Employee(s) purse(s).
6. Diaper bags.
7. Television not securely anchored.
8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
12. A mop and bucket with cleaning water was stored within the reach of the children in the toddler restroom.
13. Screws were protruding from the bases of the toilets in the toddler restroom.
14. Plastic bags were stored within the reach of the children in the toddler room.
15. Plaster was chipping off of a corner in the toddler room.
16. Shaving cream was stored within the reach of the children in the Pre-K room.
17. A table was stored on another table with the legs facing upward.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from general hazards.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in numbers 4, 10 below, on the infant outdoor play area:

1. There was broken glass.
2. There were tall weeds.
3. There was poison ivy.
4. There were tree branches.
5. There was mold visible.
6. There were thistles with pricklers.
7. There were bird droppings.
8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
9. The sandbox was contaminated.
10. Standing water.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in numbers 2, 3 below:

1. There was rust exposed;
2. There was protruding bolts;
3. There were cracks;
4. There were holes;
5. There was splintering wood;
6. There were sharp edges or points;
7. There were lead hazards;
8. There were toxic substances;
9. There were tripping hazards;
10. There was chipped and/or peeling paint;
11. Other [].

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

Code: The program is required to have the current menu posted with dates.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu, posted in the classrooms, were not currently dated as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation and Field Trip Procedures

Code: The program is required to have the parent for each child complete the required information on the trip permission form.

Finding: In review of the program's records, it was determined that the form used to secure the written permission of the parent/guardian for a field trip or routine trip was missing the required information listed in numbers 2, 4 below:

1. The child's name.
2. The date(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
3. The destination(s) of the trip(s).
4. The departure and return time(s) of the trip(s) (field trips only).
5. The signature of the parent.
6. The date on which the permission was signed.
7. A statement notifying parents how their child will be transported.
8. Other: [].

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to obtain written instructions from parents regarding feeding their infant.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review were missing information as noted in number 1 below:

1. Written instructions were not on file.
2. Type of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
3. Amount of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
4. Feeding times or frequency of feedings was missing.
5. The written instructions on file had not been updated.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

1. The JFS 01236 had not been updated as needed and at least annually.
2. The JFS 01236 had not been kept on file for one year.
3. A separate JFS 01236 had not been used for each condition.

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements

Code: The program is required to use the appropriate form and retain current documentation to administer medications. The program is also required to obtain separate documentation for each medication and child, and retain on file each JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" for at least one year.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number(s) 3 below:

1. The JFS 01217 was missing or incomplete for a topical product, food supplement, medical food.
2. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.
3. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.
4. The time period to administer the medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
5. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication.
6. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.



- 7. The JFS 01217 was not on file for one year.
- 8. The prescription label was not current.
