<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals and machinery in a place that is inaccessible to children. The

program is required to provide an outdoor play area away from machinery in operation.



<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored in Turtle classroom where children had access to it, as noted in number(s) 2 below.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 5 below, were in the Rainbow and Bears restrooms:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.

- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [ ].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Code: The program is required to use straps on equipment that is manufactured with straps.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was not used according to manufacturer's guidelines as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The straps were missing on the tables in the Butterflies and Kittens classrooms.
- 2. The straps were attached, but were not used on the [ ].
- 3. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
- 4. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [ ] were not followed in that [ ].

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide enough space between equipment to not pose a risk of injury.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor play equipment was positioned too closely to a fence, posing a risk of injury if a child were to fall from one piece of equipment into another. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 1, 2, 3 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

The program is also required to obtain separate documentation for each medication and child, and retain on file each JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" for at least one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number(s) 1, 3 below:

- 1. The JFS 01217 was missing or incomplete for a topical product, food supplement, medical food.
- 2. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.
- 3. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.
- 4. The time period to administer the medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication.
- 6. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.
- 7. The JFS 01217 was not on file for one year.
- 8. The prescription label was not current.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to retain the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file for at least one year.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the children's records, it was determined that the JFS 01236 "Medical/Physical Care Plan" did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The JFS 01236 had not been updated as needed and at least annually.
- 2. The JFS 01236 had not been kept on file for one year.
- 3. A separate JFS 01236 had not been used for each condition. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
