Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) had sole responsibility of children in the Toddler and Preschool group(s) and the JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was not on file as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the JFS 01176 or a statement that the Child Care Staff Member(s) no longer have sole responsibility of children, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the attendance records did not include all of the required information listed below:

2. The birth date of the child;
3. The assigned group;
4. The child's weekly schedule;
5. The time (hours and minutes) of each child's arrival and departure to the program, including transportation by



the program.

Information in number(s) 4 must be added to the form used to maintain attendance records. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 3 below:

1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use;
2. The floors were not being cleaned;
3. The carpets were not vacuumed;
4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep;
5. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized;
6. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized;

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to following the cleaning schedule for equipment.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner. Children's belongings need to be stored in a sanitary manner to prevent the spread of germs. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Daily Schedule

Code: The program is required to have the daily program schedule posted in all required areas.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the daily program schedule was not posted in the preschool and schoolage area as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation - Vehicle Requirements

Code: The program is required to complete and document weekly inspections of vehicles used to transport children.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the program and/or the contracted transportation company had not performed and/or documented weekly inspections of vehicles used for transporting children. The bus was observed to have at least one seat that was not mechanically safe and several seats that had rips and tears in the vinyl.

The weekly inspection needs to include the following:

1. A visual inspection of the tires for wear and tire pressure;
2. A visual inspection of headlights, taillights, signals, mirrors, wiper blades, and dash gauges;
3. An inspection for properly functioning child and driver restraints;
4. An inspection for properly functioning doors and windows;
5. An inspection for, and cleaning of, debris from inside the vehicle.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the documented weekly inspection of vehicles, and corrections to the bus seats to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

Code: The program is required to maintain a current JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" on file for each staff.

Finding: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background check requirements had not been followed, for the individual(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart, as noted in number(s) 2 below:

1. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" the program received from the Department was not on file and the individual was not left alone with children.
 2. The JFS 01177 "Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was on file instead of the JFS 01176.
 3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.
 4. The BCI criminal records check was not requested using the appropriate BCI reason code of 5104.013 as required. A new BCI check shall be submitted to the department using the correct reason code.
- Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation and Staff Records

Code: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration and Food Supplements

Code: The program is required to refrain from administering the first dose of a medication to a child.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had not received the first dose or application prior



to the program administering a dose or applying the product for any non-emergency medication, food supplement, medical food and/or topical product. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
