Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not being properly supervised as noted in number(s) 1,4 below:

1. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during indoor play.
2. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member during outdoor play.
3. Child(ren) were not within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member more than once.
4. Staff were not physically present in the space and near enough to respond and reach the child(ren) immediately.

Children must be supervised according to rule and within both sight and hearing of a child care staff member at all times. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Finding: During the inspection, equipment was determined to be unsafe or hazardous to children and in need of repair as noted in number(s) 4 below:

A walking surface that is not hazardous to children must be maintained at the program. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Code: The program is required to have an accurate menu posted.



Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that the posted menu was not accurate as noted in number(s) 2 below:

5. The signature of the parent.

7. A statement notifying parents how their child will be transported.
