# Moderate Risk Non-Compliances

### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to anchor equipment to the ground as required, to close "S" hooks to prevent the chain from slipping off and prevent strangulation and provide equipment with openings that will not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: "During the inspection, it was determined that equipment on the outdoor play space posed an imminent risk of harm to a child as noted in number(s) 7 below:

- 1. The climber was not anchored.
- 2. The swings were not securely anchored.
- 3. The slide was not securely anchored.
- 4. The climbing rope was not securely anchored at both ends.

5. The "S" hooks on the climber were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.

6. The "S" hooks on the swing(s) were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.

7. The Blue and Yellow adaptive playground equipment ladder, per discussion, had an opening that was greater than three and one-half inches, but less than nine inches. Equipment openings must be less than 3 1/2 inches or more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment.

Discontinue the use of this equipment until it has been removed, repaired or replaced. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule."

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation - Driver Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the JFS 01266 "Contracted Driver Qualifications Statement For Child Care" on file at the program for all contracted drivers.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the employee records, it was determined that the contracted driver(s) used to transport children did not have a current and complete copy of the JFS 01266 "Contracted Driver Qualification Statement for Child Care" on file at the program. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to include all information.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number(s) 4.

1. Date of examination;

2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;

- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test

a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;

b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;



c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 1; 2 below:

1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;

2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;

3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the Child Care Staff Member(s) who must complete the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written disaster plan did not meet the requirement or was missing the information in number(s) 1 below: Procedures:

1. The written disaster plan had not been completed

- 2. The plan was not provided to all child care staff and employees
- 3. The plan was not used to respond to an emergency or disaster situation



4. Weather emergencies and natural disasters which include severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, flash flooding,
major snowfall, blizzards, ice storms or earthquakes
5. Emergency outdoor and indoor lockdown or evacuation due to threats of violence which includes active
shooter, bioterrorism or terrorism
6. Emergency or disaster evacuations due to hazardous materials and spills, gas leaks or bomb threats.
7. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
8. Loss of power, water, or heat
9. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program

10. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be
reunited with the parent
11. Assisting infants and children with special needs and/or health conditions
12. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
13. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated
14. Procedures for communicating with parents during loss of communications, no phone or internet service
available
15. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to
shelter in place
16. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip
17. Training of staff or reassignment of staff duties as appropriate
18. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
19. Contact with local emergency management officials
Make the necessary revisions to the disaster plan. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes
the revised information, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
