Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to administer medication following the instructions on the JFS 01217 "Request for Administrator of Medication for Child Care" form or attached prescription label.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program had administered medication to a child and the written instructions on the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" form or attached prescription label were not followed as noted in number 1 below:

1. Medication had been administered to a child at the center at a different time than directed in that Tylenol was administered within 5 hours and not after 6 hours as indicated.

2. Medication was administered to a child for a longer or shorter period of time than directed.

3. The dose administered did not match the dosage required by the manufacturer's directions.

4. The dose administered did not match the dosage required by the written physician's instructions or the prescription label.

5. A child was administered the wrong medication provided to the program for that child.

6. Other: [].

Provide training to the staff designated to administer medication that the parent's and physician's instructions on the prescribed form, as well as instructions on the prescription label, must be followed to avoid over or under medicating a child. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the original attendance record at the center for a period of one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number 2 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained.
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed.
- 3. The original attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The material had a tear.
- 2. The material was not washable in that duct tape was being used on the floor rugs.
- 3. The material was porous.
- 4. The surface was cracked.
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning.
- 6. Other [].

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number 6 below, were in the room 6 restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilets were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.

9. Other [].

The restrooms must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all children wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one child in the infant 2 group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 3 below, as required in rule.

1. Upon arrival.

2. Prior to departure.

- 3. After toileting/diaper change.
- 4. After contact with bodily fluids.
- 5. After returning from outdoor play.

6. After handling pets, pet cages, or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet, before moving on to another activity.

7. Before eating or assisting with food preparation.

8. After water activities.

9. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water)

10. Other [].

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment <u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide nonskid rugs and correct any floor hazard that may be unsafe.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program had an area rug that did not have a nonskid backing, in that, the rugs were slippery. A walking surface that is not hazardous to children must be maintained at the program. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Handwashing Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all staff wash their hands as outlined in rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one staff member with the infant 2 group did not wash his or her hands at the time listed in number 4,7 below, as required in rule.

- 1. Upon arrival for the day.
- 2. Prior to departure.
- 3. Upon entry into a classroom.
- 4. After toileting or assisting a child with toileting (in-between each diaper change).
- 5. After each diaper change or pull-up change.
- 6. After contact with bodily fluids or cleaning up spills or objects contaminated with bodily fluids.
- 7. After cleaning or sanitizing or using any chemical products.
- 8. After handling pets, pet cages or other pet objects that have come in contact with the pet.
- 9. Before eating, serving or preparing food or bottles or feeding a child.
- 10. Before and after completing a medical procedure or administering medication.
- 11. When visibly soiled (must use soap and water).
- 12. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other [].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 Management of Communicable Disease

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to notify the parent of any child who is exhibiting symptoms of an illness.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that procedures for isolating a child due to a suspected communicable disease were not followed for the requirement listed in number 3 below:

- 1. Within sight and hearing of a staff member at all times
- 2. Cared for in another room or portion of a room away from other children



Provided with a cot or mat in that the child was falling asleep at a table.
 After use, cot or mat was not properly sanitized

Technical assistance was provided at the time of inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to serve age-appropriate fluid milk or obtain written documentation when serving substitutions for fluid milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that required documentation for substitutions for fluid milk was not on file as noted in number 2,3 below:

1. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when infants up to 12 months of age are served anything other than formula or breast milk.

2. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when infants and toddlers 12 months of age up to 24 months of age are served anything other than unflavored whole homogenized vitamin D fortified cow's milk, breast milk, or non-cow milk substitution that is nutritionally equivalent to milk.

3. Written instructions from a licensed physician, physician's assistant, or certified nurse practitioner when toddlers and children 24 months of age and older are served anything other than unflavored one per cent milk that is vitamin A and D fortified, unflavored fat free or skim milk that is vitamin A and D fortified, or non-cow milk substitutions that are nutritionally equivalent to milk.

4. Written parental consent for non-cow milk substitutions that are nutritionally equivalent to milk for children 12 months of age and older.

5. The program did not have the type of milk on-site to ensure that all children were served age-appropriate fluid milk.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide food that does not pose as a choking hazard and is appropriate for the age of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the toddler group was served apple wedges and cheese quesadilla wedges in that they both were required to be diced and cut into 1/2 inch squares, which posed a choking hazard. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide clean sheets for all cribs that are not too large or too small for the crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the appropriate form and retain current documentation to administer medications, medical foods and topical products. The program is also required to obtain separate documentation for each medication/product and child.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number 6 below:

1. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.

2. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.



3. The time period to administer the medication or medical food on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.

- 4. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication or medical food.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.

6. The prescription label was not current.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-25 Medication Administration

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to obtain signed written permission prior to administering topical products and lotions other than hand sanitizer to be used by children older than twenty-four months and lip balm.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not obtain signed written permission from the parent prior to administering topical products and lotions, other than hand sanitizer to be used by children older than twenty-four months and lip balm. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Child Medical and Enrollment Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to use the updated JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care".

<u>Finding</u>: In review of 25% of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent/guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 2 and 10 below.

- 1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
- 2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
