Rule: 5101:2-12-15 Medical/Physical Care Plans

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file at the program for any child having a health condition. The program is required to implement and/or follow instructions on the JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" for a child with a health condition.

<u>Finding</u>: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms or a medical procedure be performed at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was either not on file, implemented or followed, for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number 14 below:

- 1. No plan was on file.
- 2. Child's name was missing.
- 3. Child's date of birth was missing.
- 4. Name of the condition was missing.
- 5. Symptoms to watch for were missing.
- 6. Action to be taken if symptoms to occur were missing.

- 15. Dated signature(s) of child care staff member(s) trained to perform the procedure were missing.
- 16. Directions regarding additional services, if applicable, were missing.
- 17. Dated signature of parent giving permission to perform the procedure was missing.
- 18. Dated signature of program administrator was missing.
- 19. The plan was not implemented.
- 20. The plan was not able to be implemented due to conflicting information.
- 21. The plan was not followed.

Low Risk Non-Compliances

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following items or conditions which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in numbers 4 and 5 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- Telephone cords.

- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs. (Penguins Room)
- 5. Employee purse. (Koala Room)
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other [].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have all surge protectors and outlets covered.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that 2 surge outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers. The program must have safety covers on all electrical outlets, including power strips and surge protectors, which are within the reach of the children. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in numbers 8 and 11 below:

- 1. Cosmetics;
- 2. Disinfecting wipes;
- 3. Fish food:

- 4. Hand lotion;
- 5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months);
- 6. Laundry detergent;
- 7. Powder dish washing soap;
- 8. Paint cans;
- 9. White out;
- 10. Potting Soil;
- 11. Other potentially hazardous substance; Shaving cream with "Keep Out of Reach of Children" warning on the label.

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: Upper level art room, unlocked cabinet low shelf.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an outdoor play space that has access to bathrooms and drinking water.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were not provided access to drinking water during outdoor play, as required by this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing breast milk for a particular infant were not labeled with the date of expressed. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional Registry.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records were not entered or updated within five calendar days of the change in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for the JFS 01217 "Request for Administration of Medication for Child Care" as noted in number 3 below:

- 1. The JFS 01217 was missing or incomplete for a topical product, food supplement, medical food.
- 2. The program used an old version of the JFS 01217.
- 3. The signature date on the JFS 01217 exceeded more than 12 months.
- 4. The time period to administer the medication on the JFS 01217 was exceeded.
- 5. The JFS 01217 included more than one medication.
- 6. The JFS 01217 included more than one child's name.

- 7. The JFS 01217 was not on file for one year.
- 8. The prescription label was not current.
