Allegation: It is alleged that an inappropriate guidance technique was used in that a child was picked up by the arm.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a technique to guide a child that was not developmentally appropriate in that a child was picked up by the arm. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
