Complaint Allegations

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

Allegation: An outdoor area used by children was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence or natural barrier.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a continuous fence in good condition, or natural barrier, that ensured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in number 1 and 9 below:

- 1. The fence, natural barrier, or combination of fence and natural barrier was not continuous.
- 2. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
- 3. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 4. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 5. The gate had no latch.
- 6. The fencing was broken.
- 7. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 8. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
- 9. Other: Children were playing next to a railroad track.

Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a continuous fence or natural barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
