Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that surge protectors or outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers; infant room. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number(s) 1 below:

3. Electrical/Extension cords attached to an object that would likely result in a severe injury if pulled;

Code: The program is required to post the completed JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Plan for Child Care" and implement as required by rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the requirements for the JFS 01242 "Medical, Dental and General Emergency Plan" were not followed as noted in number(s) 1 below:

1. The plan was not posted on each level of the home used for child care.
2. The name, address and telephone number of the program were not complete.
3. The location of the first aid kit, fire extinguisher and fire alarm system, fire alarm pull stations and electrical circuit box were not complete.
4. The telephone number for emergency squad, fire department hospital, poison control program, public children services agency, local health department, local emergency management agency and police department were not complete.
5. Location of children's records was not complete.
6. Emergency information including any medications or supplies needed in the event of an evacuation was not complete.
7. The current version of the prescribed form was not used.
8. The plan was not implemented when necessary in that [ ].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements

Code: The program is required to post the fire and weather alert plan with a diagram.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined a fire and weather alert plan was not posted in a noticeable location on each level of the home in use for child care as required by rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to have equipment that does not present a safety risk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that there was equipment that presented a safety risk as noted with the number 10 below:

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu was not posted in a visible place readily accessible to parents, as required by the rule. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit [onsite/ on the vehicle/ on a field trip] as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit(s) were missing the item(s) or the item(s) were not replaced after use, when expired or damaged listed in number(s) 8 & 11 below:

1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes;
3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
4. Tweezers;
5. Gauze rolled bandage;
6. Triangular bandage;
7. Rounded end scissors;
8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
9. A working digital thermometer;
10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
11. A working flashlight; needed batteries
12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 05 Health & Safety**

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Disaster Plan

Code: The program is required to have a completed written disaster plan.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program's written disaster plan did not meet the requirement or was missing the information in number(s) 17 below:

Procedures:

1. The written disaster plan had not been completed



2. The plan was not provided to all child care staff and employees
  3. Weather emergencies and natural disasters which include severe thunderstorms, tornadoes, flash flooding, major snowfall, blizzards, ice storms or earthquakes
  4. Emergency outdoor and indoor lockdown or evacuation due to threats of violence which includes active shooter, bioterrorism or terrorism
  5. Emergency or disaster evacuations due to hazardous materials and spills, gas leaks or bomb threats.
  6. Outbreaks, epidemics or other infectious disease emergencies
  7. Loss of power, water, or heat
  8. Other threatening situations that may pose a health or safety hazard to the children in the program

9. Shelter in place or evacuation, how the program will care for and account for the children until they can be reunited with the parent

  11. Emergency contact information for parents and the program
  12. Procedures for notifying and communicating with parents regarding the location of the children if evacuated

  14. The location of supplies and procedures for gathering necessary supplies for staff and children if required to shelter in place
  15. What to do if a disaster occurs during the transport of children or when on a field trip or routine trip

  17. Updating the plan on a yearly basis
  18. Contact with local emergency management officials

Code: The program is required to have written documentation from a licensed physician if child is to be served something other than the required fluid milk.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that milk other than one per cent or skim cow's milk that is Vitamin A and D fortified was served to children older than twenty-four months of age. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

1. Child's name;
2. Date of the trip (field trips only);
3. Destination of the trip;
4. Departure and return time of the trip (field trips only);
5. Signature of the parent/guardian;
6. Date on which the permission was signed;
7. Statement notifying parents how their child will be transported;
