<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all staff request background checks as required.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks were not requested for the person(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number(s) 1 and 2 below:

- 1. Submitting the JFS 01175 "Request for a Background Check for Child Care" to the Department or the OPR;
- 2. Submitting fingerprints electronically according to the process established by BCI.

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cots and Napping

Code: The program is required to provide cots/mats that are firm, resilient, and in good condition.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that all cots were not firm, resilient, and in good repair as required by this rule, as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. Frames were bent/broken;
- 2. Covers were torn; (plastic cover on foam mat is torn)
- 3. Cots were missing bolts;
- 4. Cots were sagging;
- 5. Legs on the cots were broken;
- 6. Other [ ].

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cots and Napping

Code: The program is required to have child sleep only on cots/mats.

Finding: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was sleeping as noted in number(s) 5 below:

- 1. On the floor;
- 2. At the table;
- 3. On a bean bag chair;
- 4. On a couch or chair;
- 5. Other: In a highchair.

Children shall be provided an individually assigned cot or mat to rest, nap, or sleep. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# **Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision**

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. There was no method in place; (1 School Age Child was inside with Administrator and not with the rest of the group outside)
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 1 and 3 below, were in the Preschool restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other [ ].

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that trash was not emptied daily in the School Age Classroom. The trash must be stored in an appropriate receptacle, which is emptied daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 2, 6, and 8 below:

- 1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use.
- 2. The floors were not being cleaned. (Floors were visibly soiled from previous day)
- 3. The carpets were not vacuumed.
- 4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep.
- 5. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized.
- The sinks were not clean. (Preschool sink had residue from food and activities)
- 7. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized.
- 8. Other (Preschool Classroom Step Stool visibly soiled; Preschool Classroom Round table and black shelf had visible sticky residue; Preschool Classroom Part of an English muffin was laying in a lower open cabinet by the sink)

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed,

please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [ ].
- 12. Other Shelf in open cabinet in Preschool classroom, up the stairs, on the left, is missing a clip and is unstable and could fall.

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have all surge protectors and outlets covered.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that 2 outlets in the Preschool Classroom did not have childproof receptacle covers. The program must have safety covers on all electrical outlets, including power

strips and surge protectors, which are within the reach of the children. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

# **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Daily Schedule

Code: The program is required to have the daily program schedule posted in all required areas.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a copy of the full day program schedule was not posted in the School Age Classroom as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide adequate fall surface for the outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that while there was adequate fall surface material in the outdoor play space, proper distribution had not been maintained under and around equipment as required (under swing and end of slides). Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that fall surface material has been properly redistributed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to conduct and document quarterly inspections of their outdoor play space.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that quarterly inspections (quarter 1 - 2021) of one or more outdoor play area(s) and equipment had not been completed and documented as required, using the JFS 01281 "Child Care Playground Inspection Report" form. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

### **Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to assure all outdoor play equipment used by children is safe and designed to meet the developmental needs of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor equipment as noted in number(s) 3 below was not developmentally appropriate, as required, for the Toddler and Preschool group of children who use this equipment:

- 1. The slide(s);
- 2. The swing(s);
- 3. The climber(s); (large climber states ages 5 to 12)
- 4. Other [ ].

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

### **Domain: 06 Program Information**

Rule: 5101:2-12-14 Transportation - Driver Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all drivers transporting children complete the driver training.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one employee who is responsible for transporting children did not have documentation of completion of the prescribed driver training as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. No documentation on file
- 2. Incomplete documentation
- 3. Documentation not annually updated

- 2. Medical(s) on file were not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 6. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 7. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

- 8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
