Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to remove any items listed in rule that are a potential suffocation risk from cribs.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been placed in a crib with an object that created a potential strangulation or suffocation risk, as indicated in number(s) 12 below:

- 1. Bib
- 2. Pacifier clip/ribbon
- 3. Teething jewelry
- 4. Blanket for infant under twelve months old
- 5. Pillow
- 6. Boppie
- 7. Bumper pad
- 8. Clothing stored in the crib



- 9. Diaper bag
- 10. Object or toy strung over the crib in which a child can pull himself up
- 11. Stuffed animal that is large/soft enough to conform to the shape of the child's face
- 12. Other: Crib mattresses are wrapped in plastic.

The rule prohibits any item which obstructs child-care staff's visibility or poses a risk of strangulation or suffocation from being placed on or in a crib. Remove the item(s) immediately. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The rule requires the license to be visible to parents at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program's current license was not in a location visible to parents as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the following equipment, as noted in number(s) 4 below, was not being cleaned with soap and water and/or sanitized monthly, as required:

- 1. Cribs;
- 2. Dress-up clothes and hats;
- 3. Washable toys and equipment;



4. Other: bathroom walls unclean.

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the items noted in number(s) 2 below were not cleaned weekly, or when soiled, as required:

- 1. Carpets.
- 2. Floors and floor mats.
- 3. Washable furniture.

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use.
- 2. Reusable cloths were not being cleaned daily or when visibly soiled.
- 3. Dividers were not cleaned when visibly soiled.
- 4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep.
- 5. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized between preparing raw and cooked food.
- 6. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized.

- 7. The sinks were not clean.
- 8. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized.
- 9. Potty chairs were not emptied and/or cleaned and sanitized after each use.
- 10. Wastebaskets/trash receptacles/rinse buckets were not being cleaned and sanitized when visibly soiled.
- 11. Other [ ].

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to clean and sanitize dishes after each use.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that item(s) in the infant room were not being cleaned and sanitized after each use and prior to the next use as noted in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. Cups.
- 2. Infant spoons.
- 3. Bowls.
- 4. Silverware.
- 5. Individual containers used for water.
- 6. Sippy cups.
- 7. Plates.
- 8. Dishes.
- 9. Containers.
- 10. Bottles
- 11. Other [ ].

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment



<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store trash outside of the areas approved for child care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that storage of trash or garbage did not meet the requirement as noted in number(s) 1 below.

- 1. Trash cans/wastebaskets were not emptied daily, or more frequently as needed. Trash not emptied from day before in the toddler classroom.
- 2. Accumulated trash or garbage was stored in an area approved for child care.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## **Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to be kept clean to prevent an infestation of insects or rodents.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program was not kept clean to prevent an infestation by insects or rodents. Ants were observed on shelves in the toddler classroom and office. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in the following categories 1, 4 were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the infant classroom which includes a toddler, as required by the rule:

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants);
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;
- 3. Blocks;
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;

- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment;
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

## Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from immediate risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good repair, or other barrier. Although the fence or natural barrier was not meeting the rule requirements, it was determined to not present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground. The fence or gate was not in good repair and/or being used inappropriately as noted in number(s) 2, 3 below:

- 1. The fencing had missing slat boards.
- 2. The fencing was broken.
- 3. The fencing was loose.
- 4. The fencing was rotting.
- 5. The gate was broken and did not close.
- 6. The gate was locked.
- 7. The latch on the gate was broken.
- 8. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
- 9. The gate had no latch.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was observed that the climber posed a safety risk, in that the climber is broken (a broken swing and the top of the climber is broken). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the current weekly menu in a noticeable location that is accessible to parents and note any substitutions at the time of the change.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu did not meet the requirement as noted in number(s) 4, 6 below.

- 1. The menu was not posted.
- 2. The posted menu was not in a visible place readily accessible to parents.
- 3. The menu was not currently dated.
- 4. The entire menu was substituted.
- 5. At least one item on menu did not match what was served.
- 6. The meal or snack served did not match the posted menu. (breakfast)

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a first aid kit onsite.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined first aid kit(s) at the program had missing, or expired, items that are required by appendix A of this rule to be contained in a first aid kit, as noted in number(s) 9, 14 below:

- 1. The program did not have a first aid kit [onsite, on the vehicle, on a field trip].
- 2. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape.
- 3. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes.
- 4. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes.
- 5. Tweezers.
- 6. Gauze rolled bandage.

- 7. Triangular bandage.
- 8. Rounded end scissors.
- 9. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only).
- 10. A working digital thermometer.
- 11. Disposable non-latex gloves.
- 12. A working flashlight.
- 13. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit.
- 14. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids.
- 15. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration.
- 16. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
- 17. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

#### **Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain written instructions from parents regarding feeding their infant.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review were missing information as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Written instructions were not on file.
- 2. Type of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 3. Amount of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 4. Feeding times or frequency of feedings was missing.
- 5. The written instructions on file had not been updated.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Child Care Staff Member Educational Requirements

Code: The program staff is required to have refugee documenation on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the child care staff member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart did not have complete documentation on file verifying a copy of his or her high school diploma could not be obtained due to entering the United States as a refugee. The documentation on file did not include the required information listed in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Documentation from the federal government that the person was admitted to the United States of America as a refugee.
- 2. A notarized statement that the person received a high school diploma (or equivalent) in his or her home country prior to being admitted to the United States as a refugee.

The rule requires both pieces of information to be on file. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the required information noted above, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional Registry.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) were not created or maintained as noted in number(s) 4 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created a profile.
- 2. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not created an employment record for the program on or before their first day of employment.
- 3. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member had not updated changes to positions or roles within five calendar days of the change.
- 4. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard.
- 5. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 6. At least one individual's position or role did not include an applicable group assignment.
- 7. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 8. Other: [ ]

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files** 

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation Training & Whistle Blower Protection

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.
- 3. Completion of the training was not verified in the OPR.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### **Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all child care staff members complete training in child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention within sixty days of hire. Staff must complete training in first aid and CPR within the first ninety days of hire.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that at least one child care staff member had not completed required health and safety training as noted in number(s) 2, 3 below:

- 1. Child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was not completed within sixty days of hire.
- 2. First aid training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 3. Cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) training was not completed within ninety days of hire.
- 4. The child abuse and neglect recognition and prevention training was expired.
- 5. The first aid training was expired.
- 6. The CPR training was expired.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the child care staff member(s) who must complete the required health and safety training(s). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
