Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Equipment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to refrain from using space heaters unless it has been approved by a fire official.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a space heater which had not been approved by a fire official was in use in the area identified in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. The administrator's office.
- 2. A classroom.
- 3. The break room.

- 4. Several classrooms.
- 5. The hallway.
- 6. The entry way.
- 7. Other [].

The use of this space heater must be discontinued until approval for its use has been obtained. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes written fire approval for use of this space heater or a written statement that the space heater is no longer being used at the program, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program staff is required to remove any items listed in rule that are a potential suffocation risk from

cribs.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been placed in a crib with an object that created a potential strangulation or suffocation risk, as indicated in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. Item tied around neck (including bib or pacifier on ribbon or string around child's neck)
- 2. Blanket for infant under twelve months old
- 3. Pillow
- 4. Boppie
- 5. Bumper pad
- 6. Clothing stored in the crib
- 7. Diaper bag
- 8. Object or toy strung over the crib in which a child can pull himself up
- 9. Stuffed animal that is large/soft enough to conform to the shape of the child's face
- 10. Other: Plastic wrap the infant mattress was shipped in was not removed, a sheet was just placed over the mattress.

The rule prohibits any item which obstructs child-care staff's visibility or poses a risk of strangulation or suffocation from being placed on or in a crib. Remove the item(s) immediately. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements



<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have documentation from ODJFS, indicating the individual is eligible to be employed in child care, on file before allowing the staff to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) had sole responsibility of children in the preschool group(s) and the JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was not on file as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the JFS 01176 or a statement that the Child Care Staff Member(s) no longer have sole responsibility of children, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all staff request background checks as required.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background checks were not requested for the person(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart as noted in number(s) 1 & 2 below:

- 1. Submitting the JFS 01175 "Request for a Background Check for Child Care" to the Department or the OPR;
- 2. Submitting fingerprints electronically according to the process established by BCI.

Rule: 5101:2-12-03 Inspection Requirements

Code: The program is required to respond to noncompliances by the date noted in the inspection report.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program had not responded to the non-compliances addressed in the inspection report dated 11/26/19. The rule requires that the program provide materials to correct non-compliances detailed in written inspection reports within the timeframe outlined in the report.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that current and future corrective action plans will be submitted timely, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain a record of the arrival and departure of each child. The program is also required to retain the attendance record for a period of one year.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number(s) 1 & 2 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained; (no attendance records could be found for the current week)
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed; (last attendance record program could provide was dated of 12/4/2020)
- 3. The attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served with Child Care Staff Members who meet the requirements.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children were being supervised by an individual who did not meet the requirements of a Child Care Staff Member. Additional Child Care Staff Members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 02/06/2021

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program was not providing a clean and healthy environment, furniture, materials and equipment as required by Appendix A, as noted in number(s) 2 & 4 below:

- 1. The changing table was not sanitized after each use.
- 2. The floors were not being cleaned.(preschool floor was visably dirty with paper and food)
- 3. The carpets were not vacuumed.
- 4. The food prep areas were not being cleaned and sanitized before and after food prep. (a sheet pan containing days old pizza and tator tots was on the counter)
- 5. Toilet seat(s), handle(s) and toilet bowl(s) were not being cleaned when visibly soiled and sanitized.
- 6. The sinks were not clean.
- 7. Diaper receptacles were not being cleaned and sanitized.
- 8. Other [].

Furniture, materials and equipment must be maintained according to the cleaning and sanitizing schedule in Appendix A to this rule. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: The infant refrigerator had spoiled items stored inside causing it to smell. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. Cosmetics;
- 2. Disinfecting spray; (Multi-surface Keystone Orange was on the shelf inToddler room)
- 3. Fish food:
- 4. Hand lotion;
- 5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months);
- 6. Laundry detergent;
- 7. Powder dish washing soap;
- 8. Paint cans;
- 9. White out;
- 10. Potting Soil;
- 11. Other potentially hazardous substance [].

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: []. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-17 Materials and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have enough equipment for all children in care.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in all of the following categories were not provided in sufficient quantities for children in the infant, toddler, preschool and pre-k classrooms, as required by the rule: (classroom shelves were bare and children were in attendance, program indicated a deep cleaning would occur. The program was reminded that all classrooms needed to have the follwoing categories available to children):

- 1. Art supplies (excludes infants);
- 2. Manipulative materials and equipment;
- 3. Blocks;
- 4. Science-nature equipment (excludes infants);
- 5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
- 6. Pretend or dramatic play materials;
- 7. Music equipment;
- 8. Transportation materials and equipment;
- 9. Gross motor equipment;
- 10. Sensory motor equipment.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. There was rust exposed;
- 2. There was protruding bolts;
- 3. There were cracks;
- 4. There were holes;
- 5. There was splintering wood;
- 6. There were sharp edges or points;
- 7. There were lead hazards;
- 8. There were toxic substances;
- There were tripping hazards;
- 10. There was chipped and/or peeling paint; (yellow school bus)
- 11. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have an accurate menu posted.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the posted menu was not accurate as noted in number(s) 3 below:

- 1. The entire menu was substituted;
- 2. Item on menu did not match what was served;
- 3. The meal or snack served did not match menu posted.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

Code: The program is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when

picking up the infant each day.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no daily written record for each infant provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program is required to obtain written instructions from parents regarding feeding their infant.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that written instructions for feeding the infants noted on the Children Record Review were missing information as noted in number(s) 1below:

- 1. Written instructions were not on file.
- 2. Type of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 3. Amount of food and/or formula/breast milk was missing.
- 4. Feeding times or frequency of feedings was missing.
- 5. The written instructions on file had not been updated.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-07 Administrator Responsibilities/Requirements

Code: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional

Registry.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined employment records were not entered or updated within five calendar days of the change in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) as noted in number(s) 2, 3, 4 below:

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other: []

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in number(s) 1& 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the Child Care Staff Member(s) who must complete the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation and Staff Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training before they are permitted to have sole responsibility of children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart had sole responsibility of children and had not completed the online orientation, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 02/06/2021

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Orientation and Staff Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the online staff orientation training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that child care staff member(s) had not completed the online orientation training as noted in number(s) 1 below:

- 1. Within 30 days of starting employment at the program as a child care staff member.
- 2. No documentation of completing the training after December 31, 2016.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 1. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of 5:00 and 6:30 had expired training
- 2. First Aid child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had not taken First Aid training
- 3. First Aid trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by the program.
- 4. First Aid child care staff member scheduled during the hours of [] and [] did not have verification of completion of First Aid
- 5. CPR child care staff members scheduled during the hours of 2:00 and 4:00 had expired training
- 6. CPR child care staff scheduled during the hours of 4:00 and 6:30 had not taken CPR training
- 7. CPR trained child care staff member was not present in each building used by children
- 8. CPR child care staff member scheduled during the hours of [] and [] did not have verification of completion of CPR
- CPR training taken by staff did not include all age groups the program serves
- 10. Communicable Disease child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had expired training

- 14. Child Abuse child care staff members scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had expired training
- 15. Child Abuse trained child care staff was not in each building used by the program
- 16. Child Abuse child care staff scheduled during the hours of [] and [] had not taken Child Abuse training
- 17. Child Abuse child care staff member scheduled during the hours of and did not have verification of completion of the full six-hour Child Abuse training
- 18. Child Abuse child care staff considered to be providing coverage had only the ODJFS prescribed Child Abuse training, which does not meet this rule compliance

- 8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
