##### Domain:01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Ratio

Code: The program is required to maintain the appropriate staff to child ratio for each group served.

Findings: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for different groups on multiple occasions, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the Explorers group was 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 14 children. Additionally, a ratio of 1 Child Care Staff Member(s) for 15 children was determined for the Voyagers HS group. Both occurrences happened during nap time when children were off their cot. There were 5 children off their cots in the Explorers group and one child sitting in a chair in the Voyager HS group .



Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

10. Name and/or signature of the person completing the form;
