Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number(s) 4 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times;
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment Code: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and sanitizing as noted in number(s) 5 and 6 below:

- 1. The material had a tear;
- 2. The material was not washable;



3. The material was porous;

4. The surface was cracked;

5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning and sanitizing; the water fountain had several pieces of the surface covering ripped off, leaving a sticky residue where children place heir hands to get a drink.

6. The vinyl flooring in the School Age room and Preschool room was missing a piece of trim which would separate the types of flooring in the classrooms, leaving broken tiles exposed which were covered with a sticky substance.

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and shall be kept clean and in good repair. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a clean restroom with the appropriate materials available.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in number(s) 2, 3, 6, and 9 below, were in the "Men's" restroom, and numbers 3 and 5 in the "Women's" restroom:

- 1. There was no liquid soap.
- 2. There was no toilet paper.
- 3. There were no paper towels.
- 4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
- 5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
- 6. The toilet(s) were not flushed.
- 7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
- 8. There was a strong urine odor.
- 9. Other: dirty floor

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have all surge protectors and outlets covered.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that several outlets did not have childproof receptacle covers in the School Age classroom, where the combined group was cared for, which included an infant and a preschool aged child. The program must have safety covers on all electrical outlets, including power strips and surge protectors, which are within the reach of the children. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to store chemicals in a place that is inaccessible to children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. Cosmetics;
- 2. Disinfecting wipes;
- 3. Fish food;
- 4. Hand lotion;
- 5. Hand sanitizer (for children under 24 months);
- 6. Laundry detergent;
- 7. Powder dish washing soap;
- 8. Paint cans;
- 9. White out;
- 10. Potting Soil;

11. Other potentially hazardous substance [].

The potentially hazardous substance was determined to be accessible to children in the following area: in a low drawer in the Infant/Toddler room and in a child's cubby in the Preschool room. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance is no longer accessible to children and a statement that training was provided,

to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment Code: The program is required to provide a clean and healthy environment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: the kitchen sink drain was clogged with food and dirty water was sitting in the sink . A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint (half wall in the School Age classroom, where the combined group, which included an infant, preschooler, and school ager were cared for). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program is requird to have the current menu posted with dates.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the program's weekly menu was not currently dated as required. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.



Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide clean sheets for all cribs that are not too large or too small for the crib.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that sheets did not meet the rule requirement as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. At least one crib did not have a sheet.
- 2. At least one sheet was too large.
- 3. At least one sheet was too small.
- 4. At least one sheet was torn.
- 5. Crib sheets were not clean.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

<u>Rule</u>: 5101:2-12-08 Child Care Staff Member Educational Requirements <u>Code</u>: The program staff is required to have educational verification on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that verification of a high school education was not on file for Child Care Staff Member(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart, as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the verification of a high school education, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
