Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to follow the cleaning schedule for equipment.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the children's individual blankets and belongings were stored in an unsanitary manner. Children's belongings need to be stored in a sanitary manner to prevent the spread of germs. - 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
