Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following equipment was not used according to manufacturer's guidelines as noted in number 2 below:

1. The straps were missing on the [ ].
2. The straps were attached, but were not used on the bucket seat in the Infant B classroom while an infant was eating snack.
3. The straps were attached and were used, but were not used in a safe manner.
4. Manufacturer's guidelines for the [ ] were not followed in that [ ].

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following unsanitary conditions were at the program: a dog was allowed to eat food off of the table while infants were eating snack and an infant was determined to have fed the dog food while eating snack. A clean and healthy environment, including furniture, materials and equipment must be provided, and the program shall be cleaned daily. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
