Allegation: The complainant alleged that a teacher used inappropriate guidance and management techniques including harshly yelling, pushing a child, putting a jacket on a child backwards, and holding a child in a small space behind a door.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child care staff member used a discipline technique to guide or discipline child(ren) that was not developmentally appropriate, consistent, or occurred at the time of the incident. This included placing a jacket on a child backwards and holding a child in a small space behind a door opening. After conducting staff interviews concerning the incident, it was unable to be determined if inappropriate yelling, pushing, restraining, or prohibited techniques were used. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
