<u>Code</u>: The program is required to post the sign prohibiting any person from carrying a deadly weapon on the premises.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection it was determined that the sign prohibiting any person, other than law enforcement, from carrying a deadly weapon on the program premises, in accordance with section 2923.1212(A)(8) of the Revised Code, did not meet the rule requirements as noted in number(s) 2 below:

- 1. The sign was not posted;
- 2. The sign was posted, but did not contain required information.

During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint (3/4's restroom wall near toilets and outside of door to playground off 3's room). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Space Requirements

Code: The program is required to have an outdoor play space free from general hazards.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. There was broken glass.
- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were tree branches.
- 5. There was mold visible.
- 6. There were thistles with prickers.
- 7. There were bird droppings.
- 8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
- 9. The sandbox was contaminated.
- 10. The black mesh weed barrier was protruding through the mulch in several areas on the large playground causing a tripping hazard.
