<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the information in number 4 below was not up to date in the Ohio Child Licensing and Quality System (OCLQS):

- 2) Telephone Number
- 3) Email Address
- 4) Days and Hours of Operation
- 5) Services Offered
- 6) Name of Program

Technical assistance was provided, and as discussed, log on to OCLQS and update the information, as required.

Domain: 01 Ratio & Supervision

Rule: 5101:2-12-18 Attendance Records

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have a method for tracking the children in each group. The tracking method must be updated throughout the day and kept with the group at all times.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the method for tracking children in each group did not meet the requirements of the rule as noted in number 4 below:

- 1. There was no method in place;
- 2. The method did not include each child's name;
- 3. The method did not include each child's date of birth;
- 4. The tracking method did not remain with the group at all times; (Care Bears group)
- 5. The tracking method was not updated throughout the day as children entered or left the group.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that at least one area of the program or at least one piece of equipment had chipping or peeling paint (on door of Muffy classroom). Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-13 Sanitary Equipment and Environment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment and materials that are easy to clean.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that at least one piece of equipment, furnishings, or material at the program was not constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and sanitizing as noted in number 2 below:

- 1. The material had a tear; (climber in the Pooh's Place classroom)
- 2. The material was not washable;
- 3. The material was porous;
- 4. The surface was cracked;
- 5. The surface was repaired, but in a manner that still did not facilitate cleaning and sanitizing;
- 6. Other [].

Equipment, furnishings, and furniture shall be constructed of materials to facilitate cleaning and shall be kept clean and in good repair. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-12-12 Safe Environment

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide an environment that protects the children in care from any items and conditions that may threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following item(s) or condition(s) which may threaten their health, safety, or well-being as noted in number 4 and 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop.
- 2. Telephone cords.
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs. (Beach and Cubs classroom)
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following classroom furniture: [].
- 12. Other [plastic bags accessible to children in the Corduroy restroom area].

Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Equipment

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that does not pose a safety risk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that outdoor play equipment was unsafe as noted in number 1 below:

- 1. There was rust exposed; (swings on the preschool playground 1)
- 2. There was protruding bolts;
- 3. There were cracks;
- 4. There were holes;
- 5. There was splintering wood;
- 6. There were sharp edges or points;
- 7. There were lead hazards;
- 8. There were toxic substances;
- 9. There were tripping hazards;
- 10. There was chipped and/or peeling paint;
- 11. Other [].

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 08/29/2021

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-12-11 Outdoor Play Fall Zones

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide fall zones around equipment to prevent injury if a child were to fall.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a climber on the toddler playground for building one was positioned such that the fall zone for number 4 below was not met:

- 1. The fall zone did not extend six feet from the point of furthest extension;
- 2. The fall zone was less than 6 feet from fence;
- 3. The fall zone was less than 9 feet from each piece of applicable equipment;
- 4. There was not a fall zone of 6 feet in all directions from the perimeter of the equipment; (climbers on the toddler playground 2)
- 5. Other [].

The program is required to provide equipment that is safe with adequate fall zones. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 08/29/2021

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Meal and Snack Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide food that does not pose as a choking hazard and is appropriate for the age of the children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that a child was served whole grapes in the Paw preschool group, which posed a choking hazard. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-12-16 First Aid/Standard Precautions

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have the appropriate number of first aid kits for the program.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the first aid supplies were not stored according to the requirements listed in item number 1 below:

- 1. Stored in a clearly marked container. (for the vehicle first aid kit)
- 2. Stored in an unlocked container.
- 3. Stored out of the reach of children.
- 4. In each building.
- 5. On each floor.
- 6 For every 75 children in attendance.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 06 Program Information

Rule: 5101:2-12-24 Swimming and Water Safety Requirements

Code: The program is required to obtain parental permission before a swimming activity.

<u>Finding</u>: In the review of the program's records, it was determined that written parental permission had not been secured before a swimming activity as defined in number 2 below:

- 1. A child swims or plays in water eighteen inches or more in depth;
- 2. A child participates in activities near, in, or on water eighteen inches or more in depth;
- 3. Infants and toddlers use wading pools;
- 4. Written permission was not updated annually for on-going activities.

Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Domain: 08 Staff Files

Rule: 5101:2-12-08 Medical Statement

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to include all information.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the medical statements for those employees listed on the Employee Record Chart did not include the required information listed below in number 3b. 3c. 4a.

- 1. Date of examination;
- 2. Signature, business address, and telephone number of the licensed physician, physician assistant, advanced practice nurse, certified midwife, or certified nurse practitioner who completed the examination;
- 3. A statement that verifies that the employee is:
- a. Physically fit for employment in a program caring for children;
- b. Immunized against Tetanus, Diphtheria, Pertussis (Tdap);
- c. Immunized against Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR);
- 4. Tuberculosis (TB) screening/test
- a. Documentation of the screening process to determine if the employee resided in a country identified by the World Health Organization as having a high burden of TB and arrived in the United States within the five years preceding the date of application for employment;
- b. Results of a TB test for employees meeting both criteria in 4a;
- c. Results of additional testing for employees with a positive TB test;
- d. Written statement, signed by a representative of the TB control unit, that the employee's TB is no longer infectious or the individual is receiving a TB treatment regimen for employees with a positive TB test.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the completed employee medical statement, or TB results/documentation, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-10 Health Training Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to have staff complete the required one hour prescribed Child Abuse training.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that the requirement for the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training was not met as noted in numbers 1 and 2 below:

- 1. The training was not completed within sixty days of hire;
- 2. The training expired, as it is only valid for two years;
- 3. Not all administrators, Child Care Staff Members, and substitutes have completed the training.

Refer to the Employee Record Chart for the name(s) of the Child Care Staff Member(s) who must complete the ODJFS one-hour prescribed Child Abuse Training. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-12-09 Background Check Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to receive a preliminary approval from ODJFS prior to allowing an individual to engage in assigned duties or be near children.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that individual(s) had engaged in assigned duties or were near children and preliminary approval from ODJFS was not on file as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the preliminary approval or a statement that the individual(s) are no longer engaged in assigned duties and is not near children, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program administrator is required to maintain current employee records in the Ohio Professional

- 1. At least one administrator, employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
- 2. The administrator had not assigned at least one employee or child care staff member to the program's organization dashboard in the OPR.
- 3. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
- 4. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
- 5. At least one individual's employment had not been end dated.
- 6. Other: []
