Code: The program staff is required to remove any items listed in rule that are a potential suffocation risk from cribs.
Allegation: Complainant alleges that infants were sleeping in cribs with blankets.
Determination: Substantiated
Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that a child had been placed in a crib with an object that created a potential strangulation or suffocation risk, as indicated in number 4 below:
 Bib Pacifier clip/ribbon Teething jewelry Blanket for infant under twelve months old Pillow Boppie Bumper pad Clothing stored in the crib Diaper bag Object or toy strung over the crib in which a child can pull himself up Stuffed animal that is large/soft enough to conform to the shape of the child's face Other []
The rule prohibits any item which obstructs child-care staff's visibility or poses a risk of strangulation or suffocation from being placed on or in a crib. Remove the item(s) immediately. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
