Code: The program is required to provide a copy of the JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care" to parents or the person picking up the child on the day of the incident.

Allegation: The complainant alleged that an incident was not provided for injuries that occurred while a child was at the program.

**Determination**: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that parents or a person picking up a child did not receive the JFS 01299 "Incident/Injury Report For Child Care" on the day of the incident, as required by the rule (staff reported that an incident report was provided the next day after the family asked questions about marks on the child). Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance and submit written response.
