<u>Finding</u>: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. - 2. Telephone cords. (Telephone on top of high cabinet with hanging cord in room 11)
- 3. Electrical/extension cords attached to an object that would not likely result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 4. Stacked chairs.
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s).
- 6. Diaper bags.
- 7. Television not securely anchored.
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 9. Smoke detector needing batteries replaced.
- 10. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child.
