<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide toys that are not small enough to be a choking hazard for infants and toddlers.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined there were toys or other items, small enough to be swallowed present, in the space where infants and/or toddlers were in care. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
