<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirements for keeping an attendance record as listed in number 2 below:

- 1. No attendance record was being maintained;
- 2. The attendance record was not being consistently completed; a child from the preschool group was sleeping in toddler area, but was not added to the attendance in the toddler group.
- 3. The attendance documentation was not kept at the program for a period of one year.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the outdoor play equipment was positioned too closely together, posing a risk of injury if a child were to fall from one piece of equipment into another. - 2. The JFS 01177 Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care was on file instead of the JFS 01176.

3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.
