Complaint Allegations

Allegation: No additional adult is available during routine walking trips.

Determination: Substantiated

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an additional adult did not accompany the school age group of children and Child Care Staff Member walking during routine trip to school. To ensure the safety of children, an additional adult must be present on all trips for every five infants; any combination of seven or more toddlers, preschool and school children; and every ten school children if the group includes only school children on a walking trip. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.
