**Domain: 09 Children's Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Health Conditions

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file for each health condition for each child.

Findings: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms or a medical procedure be performed at the program. In review of the children's records, it was determined that the required written information was not on file for at least one child indicated on the Children Records Review, as noted in number 1 below:

1. No plan was on file.
2. Child's name was missing.
3. Child's date of birth was missing.
4. Name of the condition was missing.
5. Symptoms to watch for were missing.
6. Action to be taken if symptoms to occur were missing.

Code: The program is required to appropriately store medication.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not meet the requirement for administering a medication, food supplement or medical food to a child as noted in number 1 below:

7. The time to administer was missing on the JFS 01217. 7. The time period to administer was missing on the JFS 01217.

10. Expiration date was missing on the JFS 01217.
11. Physician instructions were missing on the JFS 01217.
12. Physician's dated signature was missing on the JFS 01217.
13. Physician's phone number was missing on the JFS 01217.
14. Date medication was administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
15. Time medication was administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
16. Dosage administered was missing on the JFS 01217.
17. Staff member's signature was missing on the JFS 01217.
18. A current prescription label was not attached to the prescription medication.
19. The medication or product, [ ], was not brought to the program in its original container.

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number 4 below, were in the program restroom:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet tissue.
3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet was not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.
9. Other [ ].

The restroom must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the daily schedule was not posted in the program with all hours of operation. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

#### Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Fluid Milk

Code: The program is required to have written documentation from a licensed physician if child is to be served something other than the required fluid milk.



Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that there was no documentation from a licensed physician or parent as required by the rule, when children between 12 and 24 months of age were served anything other than whole homogenized Vitamin D fortified fluid milk. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 02/21/2020

**Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care**

Rule: 5101:2-13-23 Infant Bottle and Food Preparation

Code: The program staff is required to have all bottles labeled.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing formula for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Requirements

Code: The provider is required to have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider did not have hours of availability posted in a noticeable place. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

**Domain: 08 Staff Files**

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Requirements

Code: The provider is required to maintain the required liability insurance or have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" on file for each child in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the provider did not have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" completed for each child in care. Correct the violation and submit proof of insurance with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 JFS 01234 'Child Enrollment and Health Information'

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information for Child Care" on file on the premises for each child.

Findings: In review of the children's records, it was determined that information had not been secured from the parent or guardian on the JFS 01234 "Child Enrollment and Health Information For Child Care", as required, for the items in numbers 3,7,9 & 14 below:

1. No enrollment form was completed for at least one child
2. The current JFS 01234 was not completed for at least one child
3. Complete parent information
4. Complete emergency contact information
5. Complete physician information
6. Information regarding the parent list
7. Health information
8. Additional information for all boxes checked "yes"
9. Emergency transportation information
10. Parent/guardian's signature
11. Diapering Statement
12. Acknowledgement of Policies and Procedures
13. Enrollment form for at least one child was not updated by either the parent or the administrator
14. Enrollment form for at least one child was not signed by the administrator

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Requirements

Code: The program is required to have policies and procedures for all items listed in this rule.

1. Name, address, email address and telephone number.

4. Staff/child ratios and group size.
5. Meals and snacks provided.
6. Outdoor play, including limitations placed on outdoor play due to weather or safety issues. Considerations may include but are not limited to temperature, humidity, wind chill, ozone levels, pollen count, lightning, rain or ice.



7. Opportunities for parent involvement in activities.
8. Opportunities for parents to meet with the provider regarding their child.
9. Payment schedule, overtime charges and registration fees as applicable.
10. Programs shall have a policy in place describing supports for onsite breastfeeding or pumping for mothers who wish to do so (if the program serves infants or toddlers).

#### Provider Policies and Procedures

11. Enrollment including required enrollment information.
12. Care of children without immunizations.
13. Attendance including procedures for arrival and departure, the program's absent day policy, releasing child to persons other than the parent, releasing a child according to a custody agreement and follow up when a child scheduled to arrive from another program or activity does not arrive.
14. Supervision and child guidance.
15. Parent provided food and provider dietary policy, if applicable. If all of the food is parent provided, the policy shall also include if the provider supplements food when the parent does not provide sufficient food for the day.
16. Management of illness including isolation precautions, symptoms for discharge and return, notification of parent of ill child and whether or not the provider will care for sick children.
17. Summary of procedures taken in the event of an emergency, serious illness or injury.
18. Administration of medication including food supplements, modified diets and whether school age children are permitted to carry their own medication and ointments.
19. Transportation for trips and emergencies.
20. Water activities/swimming.
21. Infant care, if applicable, including frequency of diaper checks.
22. Napping and Resting.
23. Evening and overnight care, if applicable.
24. Policy on operation and/or closing due to weather, school delays or closings and any other factors.
25. Policy on the provider using a substitute or child care staff member pursuant to 5101:2-13-08 of the Administrative Code for sick days, vacations or other time off.
26. Policy on when the provider will require dis enrollment of a child
27. Procedure for parents or employees to follow when needing assistance in resolving problems related to the family child care home.
28. Policy on whether or not the provider will provide child care services to children whose parents refuse to grant consent for transportation to the source of emergency treatment.
29. Policy on whether the program conducts formal assessments on enrolled children and if the Enrollment including required enrollment information.
