Code: The program is required to follow group size requirements.



<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined 7 children with 3 under two years of age were in the care of 2 child care staff members which resulted in more than six children. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, a toxic substance was stored where children had access to it as noted in number 2 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in program space.

Code: The program is required to refrain from exposing children to smoking paraphernalia.

<u>Findings</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that children had access and/or were exposed to smoking paraphernalia as noted in the following number 1 below:

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined that a crib/playpen, assigned to a child, was used for storage. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
