Rule: 5101:2-13-19 Supervision

Code: The program is required to supervise children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that one child was unattended, exiting the front door five times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being.

Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any items and conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well-being. During the inspection, it was determined the program did not protect children from an unsafe item or condition or equipment due to the following number(s) [5, 17] below:

1. Pull cord(s) on the window blind(s).
2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
3. Stacked tables.
4. Folding tables.
5. Matches and/or a lighter.
6. Power tool(s).

 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
 9. Asbestos.
 10. Traffic.
 11. A body of water.

 16. Large or heavy pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
 17. Other [Broken spindles on the stairs and a sledge hammer out in the play area].
- A lighter was located in child's toy area within reach and access. Spindles are broken/missing from staircase. A sledge hammer was located inside the home in the play area.
- Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program is required to use an outdoor space that is protected from traffic and other hazards with a barrier.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an area was used which was not protected from traffic and other hazards by a fence in good condition, or other barrier, that assured children were not able to leave the playground area. The fence or natural barrier was determined to present an immediate risk for a child to be able to leave the playground as noted in number [] below:

1. The fencing had missing slat boards through which children could leave the playground.
2. The gate was broken and did not close.
3. The latch on the gate was broken.
4. The gate had no latch.
5. The fencing was broken.
6. The latch was easily opened by children on the playground.
7. The portable fencing approved for use by the Department was not being used.
8. Other [play area being used is an empty lot owned by someone else with hazards of broken broken bricks, bent piping, and no fencing]

Discontinue use of the playground and provide a space for outdoor play which is well defined by a fence or other barrier and protected from other hazards. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to have a completed JFS 01236 "Medical/Physical Care Plan" on file for each health condition for each child.

Findings: A written, signed and dated JFS 01236 "Child Medical/Physical Care Plan" must be on file for any child having health conditions which require monitoring for symptoms or a medical procedure be performed at the program. 18. The plan was not implemented.
19. The plan was not followed.

No plan was on file for two children -(one child has asthma and one child with ADHD).

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the basement did not contain a working smoke detector. Obtain a smoke detector and submit the purchase receipt as part of the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

1. The provider, resident, child care staff member or employee did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering.
2. At least one school-age child did not wear a face covering while indoors and it was medically or developmentally appropriate for the individual to wear a face covering.
3. At least one individual's face covering did not cover their nose and mouth.
4. At least one child under two years old wore a face covering.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspections, a potentially hazardous substance, which was determined to not present a serious risk to a child, was accessible to children as noted in number(s) 8 below:

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment

Code: The program is required to store trash in an area that is not accessible to children.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that there were no provisions for the storage of accumulated trash, rubbish or garbage in the [outdoor] play area which was accessible to children. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to have all outlets and surge protectors covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that surge protectors or outlets (downstairs play area, and upstairs hallway) did not have childproof receptacle covers. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Smoke Free

Code: The program is required to provide notification to parents if smoking occurs on the premises outside of operating hours.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that smoking had occurred in the program building or vehicle during hours the program was not in operation; however, parents had not been given written notice of this. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Smoke Free

Code: The program is required to refrain from exposing children to smoking paraphernalia.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that children had access and/or were exposed to smoking paraphernalia as noted in the following number(1, 3, 4) below:

1. Cigarettes;
2. Cigars;
3. Pipe butts;
4. Ashes;
5. Chewing or smokeless tobacco;
6. Electronic cigarettes;
7. Vaporizers;
8. Other [].

Cigarette extinguishing cup with a butted out cigarette was located inside child's chair cupholder on the front porch. Cigarette butts were located in the outside yard, and one ashtray was inside the home on the counter. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program staff is required to protect the children from hazardous conditions in the outdoor play area.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) [10] below:

1. There was broken glass.
2. There were tall weeds.
3. There was poison ivy.
4. There were protruding bolts.
5. There were tree branches.
6. There was mold visible.
7. The sandbox was contaminated.
8. There were thistles with pricklers.
9. There were bird droppings.
10. Other [protruding poles sticking up from the ground].

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to safely store food.

Findings: During this inspection, it was determined that food was not stored in a safe manner in that [the refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit. Temperature was 45.4] Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 07/01/2021

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit [onsite/ on the vehicle/ on a field trip] as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit(s) were missing the item(s) or the item(s) were not replaced after use, when expired or damaged listed in number(s) [9, 11] below:

1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes;
3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
4. Tweezers;
5. Gauze rolled bandage;
6. Triangular bandage;
7. Rounded end scissors;
8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
9. A working digital thermometer;
10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
11. A working flashlight;
12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;
14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);



16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).
No digital thermometer and flashlight not working
Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Code: The program is required to post a current menu for the week.

Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that the current menu for this week was not posted. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the preliminary approval or a statement that the individual(s) are no longer engaged in assigned duties and is not near children, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule. -The provider denied having any staff or employees, later calling a friend for help. When the friend arrived, provider prepared meals for the children.
