Code: The program is required to have a written evacuation plan located on the appropriate levels.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined a written evacuation plan was not located on the following levels of the program [ First Floor ]. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that unsanitary conditions, as noted in the following number(s) 2 below, were in the downstairs restroom used by children under care:

1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet tissue.
3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet was not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.

The restroom(s) must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to provide a designated storage area for children's personal belongings.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the provider did not have designated storage areas for children's personal belongings, in that there was no area designated to each individual child where personal belongings could be store appropriately and separate from other children's belongings. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

9. Gross motor equipment;
10. Sensory motor equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment and materials in at least five of the nine categories listed below were not adequate to meet the developmental needs of the children/sufficient that each child can be actively involved in an activity for the school-age children in the activities area/classroom, as required by the rule: 5101:2-13-17.

1. Art supplies;

5. Language arts and auditory materials and equipment;
6. Music equipment;
7. Transportation materials and equipment;
8. Sports and gross motor equipment;
9. Pretend or dramatic play materials.

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a first aid kit [onsite/ on the vehicle/ on a field trip] as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit(s) were missing the item(s) or the item(s) were not replaced after use, when expired or damaged listed in number(s) 4, 8, 9, and 11 below:

1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;
2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze squares in assorted sizes;
3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
4. Tweezers;
5. Gauze rolled bandage;
6. Triangular bandage;
7. Rounded end scissors;
8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);
9. A working digital thermometer;
10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
11. A working flashlight;
12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;
13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;



14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;
15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-10 Health Training B

Code: The program is required to meet the health training requirements.

Findings: In review of records, it was determined the provider did not have current valid documentation for training(s) listed in number(s) [3, 7, 10, 14 ] below:

3. First Aid - not have verification of completion of First Aid
4. First Aid - Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.

16. Child Abuse Recognition and Prevention - Documentation did not demonstrate the person who provided the training met the trainer qualifications as stated in the rule.
