Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to provide rugs that have a nonskid backing and replace any floor surface that may be unsafe.

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined that the provider had an area rug that did not have a nonskid backing or a floor surface that was unsafe in that the rug is on top of wood floor which is highly slippery & the provider slipped & almost fell walking on it. Also, the area is accessible to children and has the toddler play pens in it. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 04/27/2022

Domain: 07 Diapering & Infant Care

Rule: 5101:2-13-20 Crib and Playpen Requirements Code: The program is required to use a crib/playpen according to manufacturer's guidelines.

<u>Findings:</u> During the inspection, it was determined that a playpen was not being used according to manufacturer's instructions in that the mattress needs to strapped down and fastened at each end. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
