Code: The program is required to store alcohol in a space not used by children.

Findings: During the inspection, alcohol was determined to be in a space that was accessible to children, in the kitchen in several places. Wine, Bacardi and ready made Margarita mix. These items must be removed or stored in space not approved or used for children as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with this rule.

#### Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-13-04 Flammable and Combustible Materials in Type B Home Code: The program is required to properly store flammable and combustible materials and substances.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined flammable and combustible materials and substances were stored near number(s) 2 below:

- 2. Extension cord(s); electrical cord(s) attached to an object that could result in a severe injury if pulled.
- 3. Stacked tables.
- 4. Folding tables.

- 6. Power tool(s).
- 7. Live wires.
- 8. Stove(s) that are either on or able to be turned on by a child.
- 9. Asbestos.
- 10. Traffic.
- 11. A body of water.
- 12. A well.
- 13. Environmental hazard(s) confirmed by local authorities having jurisdiction over the hazard.
- 14. A crockpot used to heat bottles.
- 15. Immediate access to a knife.
- 16. Large or heavy pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall.
- 17. Other plugged in deep fryer, scissors, screw driver, wine bottle opener in kitchen drawer. Wet mop on basement steps.

Any hazardous equipment must be removed, replaced, or repaired and any hazardous condition must be corrected and must be made inaccessible to children. Provide staff training. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the item or condition has been removed and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a potentially hazardous item or toxic substance was used or stored where children had access to it as noted in number(s) 1, 2 and 7 below. The potentially hazardous substance or item that posed a risk to children was determined to be accessible to children in kitchen and basement.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the potentially hazardous substance or item is no longer accessible to children and/or children will not be outside when machinery is in use and a statement that training was provided, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were protruding bolts.
- 5. There were tree branches.

- 7. The sandbox was contaminated.

- 9. There were bird droppings.

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.
