**Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-13 Clean Environment and Equipment

Code: The program is required to have all required items in the restroom(s) and keep them sanitary.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that an unsanitary condition, as noted in the following number 4 below, were in the program restroom:



1. There was no liquid soap.
2. There was no toilet tissue.
3. There were no individually assigned towels or disposable towels.
4. The toilet cleaning brush was accessible to the children.
5. The plunger was accessible to the children.
6. The toilet was not flushed.
7. The trash was not emptied from the day before.
8. There was a strong urine odor.
9. Other [ ].

The restroom must be kept sanitary at all times. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Code: The program is required to remove toys or other items that may be a choking hazard from infants and toddlers.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined there was a paper clip on the floor, small enough to be swallowed, present in the space where infants or toddlers were in care. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/21/2021

**Domain: 03 Postings & Equipment**

Rule: 5101:2-13-17 Programming

Code: The program is required to have a daily schedule posted in a visible place.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the posted daily schedule did not match the program's hours of operation. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Corrective Action Plan Due: 11/27/2021

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Equipment

Code: The program is required to place equipment away from main traffic patterns that would create unsafe conditions.



Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that the swing set posed a safety risk, in that it was broken and not anchored. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

**Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space**

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Outdoor Space

Code: The program staff is required to protect the children from hazardous conditions in the outdoor play area.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the following hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number 10 below:

1. There was broken glass.
2. There were tall weeds.
3. There was poison ivy.
4. There were protruding bolts.
5. There were tree branches.
6. There was mold visible.
7. The sandbox was contaminated.
8. There were thistles with pricklers.
9. There were bird droppings.
10. Other-trash and charcoal on the ground

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

**Domain: 05 Health & Safety**

Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to safely store food.

Findings: During this inspection, it was determined that food was not stored in a safe manner in that the refrigerator did not maintain a temperature of 40 degrees Fahrenheit or below. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-09 Background Checks

Code: The program is required to have the applicable JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" on file.

Findings: In review of the staff records, it was determined that background check requirements had not been followed, for the individual listed on the Employee Record Chart, as noted in number 1 below:

1. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" the program received from the Department was not on file and the individual was not left alone with children.
2. The JFS 01177 "Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care" was on file instead of the JFS 01176.
3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.
4. The JFS 01176 "Program Notification of Background check Review for Child Care" was not on file at the program, but was on file at the county agency and the individual is eligible.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that employment records were not entered five calendar days of the change in the Ohio Professional Registry (OPR) as noted in number 2 below:

1. At least one employee or child care staff member (including substitutes) had not created an employment record in the OPR for the program.
2. At least one resident had not created an employment record in the OPR for the family child care provider within five days of becoming a resident or turning eighteen.
3. The provider had not assigned at least one employee, child care staff member (including substitutes), or resident to the program's organization dashboard.
4. At least one individual's schedule was not current.
5. At least one individual's position or role was not current.
6. At least one individual's employment or residence had not been end dated.

1. Name, address, email address and telephone number.

3. Days and hours of operation, scheduled closings and basic daily schedule.
4. Staff/child ratios and group size.
5. Meals and snacks provided.
6. Outdoor play, including limitations placed on outdoor play due to weather or safety issues. Considerations may include but are not limited to temperature, humidity, wind chill, ozone levels, pollen count, lightning, rain or ice.
7. Opportunities for parent involvement in activities.
8. Opportunities for parents to meet with the provider regarding their child.



- 9. Payment schedule, overtime charges and registration fees as applicable.
- 10. Programs shall have a policy in place describing supports for onsite breastfeeding or pumping for mothers who wish to do so (if the program serves infants or toddlers).

Provider Policies and Procedures

- 11. Enrollment including required enrollment information.
- 12. Care of children without immunizations.
- 13. Attendance including procedures for arrival and departure, the program's absent day policy, releasing child to persons other than the parent, releasing a child according to a custody agreement and follow up when a child scheduled to arrive from another program or activity does not arrive.
- 14. Supervision and child guidance.
- 15. Parent provided food and provider dietary policy, if applicable. If all of the food is parent provided, the policy shall also include if the provider supplements food when the parent does not provide sufficient food for the day.

- 22. Napping and Resting.
- 23. Evening and overnight care, if applicable.
- 24. Policy on operation and/or closing due to weather, school delays or closings and any other factors.
- 25. Policy on the provider using a substitute or child care staff member pursuant to 5101:2-13-08 of the Administrative Code for sick days, vacations or other time off.
- 26. Policy on when the provider will require dis enrollment of a child
- 27. Procedure for parents or employees to follow when needing assistance in resolving problems related to the family child care home.
- 28. Policy on whether or not the provider will provide child care services to children whose parents refuse to grant consent for transportation to the source of emergency treatment.
- 29. Policy on whether the program conducts formal assessments on enrolled children and if the Enrollment including required enrollment information.
