Rule: 5101:2-12-20 Cribs

Code: The program is required to put all crib mattresses in their lowest position.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the mattress support was not maintained at the lowest position for all cribs when in use, as required. An infant was placed in a crib and one side was not raised in the highest position. Except when infants are being placed in cribs, removed from cribs, or being soothed, the sides should remain in the highest position. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.
