## **Moderate Risk Non-Compliances**

#### Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to meet all requirements for carbon monoxide detectors.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the Type B Home did not have a working carbon monoxide detector on 2nd floor where care is provided. Carbon monoxide detector was not placed in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. A working carbon monoxide detector must be placed and maintained in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with this rule.

# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to refrain from using and storing outdoor machinery around children.

Findings: During the inspection, a toxic substance was stored where children had access to it as noted in number 9 below: The toxic substance posed a risk to children and was determined to be accessible to children. In that, the toxic substance needs to be stored in a place not accessible to children.

1. Bleach.

- 2. Cleaning agent.
- 3. Fish tank chemicals.
- 4. Gasoline.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the toxic substance is no longer accessible to children to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to provide equipment that has openings less than 3 1/2 inches and no more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that equipment on the outdoor play space posed an imminent risk of harm to a child as noted in numbers 5 below:

- 1. The climber was not anchored.
- 2. The swings were not securely anchored.
- 3. The slide was not securely anchored.
- 4. The climbing rope was not securely anchored at both ends.

5. The "S" hooks on the climber were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.

6. The "S" hooks on the swings were not closed in order to prevent the chain from slipping off the hook and prevent strangulation.

7.The [ ] had an opening that was greater than three and one-half inches, but less than nine inches.

Equipment openings must be less than 3 1/2 inches or more than 9 inches to avoid the risk of entrapment. Discontinue the use of this equipment until it has been removed, repaired or replaced. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

#### Domain: 09 Children's Files

Rule: 5101:2-13-25 Medication Storage

Code: The program is required to store medication out of the reach of children.



Findings: During the inspection, it was determined medication was in the reach of children. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

# Low Risk Non-Compliances

## Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes Code: The program is required to follow all requirements in rule regarding emergency exits and operational conditions.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the following requirements regarding emergency exits and operational conditions were not met by the program, in that the program was using an unauthorized space in the basement area. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

# Domain: 00 License & Approvals

Rule: 5101:2-13-04 Fire Safety for Type B Homes Code: The program is required to have all electrical connections in junction boxes properly covered.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the electrical connections in the junction box in the outdoor space were not properly covered. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

# Domain: 02 Safe & Sanitary Environment

Rule: 5101:2-13-12 Safe Environment

Code: The program is required to protect children in care from items and conditions that threaten their health, safety, and well being.



Findings: Children in care shall be protected from any conditions which threaten their health, safety, and well being. During the inspection, it was determined that children were not protected from the following condition which may threaten their health, safety, or well being as noted in the following number 12 below:

- 1. Open pull cords that are not closed loop;
- 2. Telephone cords;
- 3. Electrical/Extension cords attached to an object that would likely result in a severe injury if pulled;
- 4. Stacked chairs;
- 5. Employee(s) purse(s);
- 6. Diaper bags;
- 7. Television not securely anchored;
- 8. Small or lightweight pieces of shelving units are not securely anchored to the wall;
- 9. Staff member stepped over a barrier/gate while holding a child;
- 10. Chipping or peeling paint;
- 11. Emergency exits were blocked by the following furniture: [];
- 12. Other Kitchen cabinet needs a lock

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

#### Domain: 04 Indoor/Outdoor Space

Rule: 5101:2-13-11 Fall Zone

Code: The program is required to have a fall surface for outdoor equipment.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that while there was adequate fall surface material in the outdoor play space, proper distribution had not been maintained under and around equipment as required. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that fall surface material has been properly redistributed, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 First Aid Kit

Code: The program is required to meet the requirements for first aid kits.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the program did not have a complete first aid kit onsite as required, that included all items listed in the appendix A of the rule. The kit was missing the item listed in number 5 below:

1. One roll of hypoallergenic first-aid tape;



2. Individually wrapped sterile gauze

- squares in assorted sizes;
- 3. Sterile adhesive bandages in assorted sizes;
- 4.Tweezers;
- 5. Gauze rolled bandage;
- 6. Triangular bandage;
- 7. Rounded end scissors;

8. Tooth preservation system or fresh chilled liquid milk in which to transport a lost permanent tooth, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where milk is stored if a tooth preservation system is not part of the first aid kit (for programs serving school age children only);

- 9. A working digital thermometer;
- 10. Disposable non-latex gloves;
- 11. A working flashlight;

12. An instant cold pack that has not been activated or ice, including a written reference indicating location of the refrigerator/freezer where the ice is stored if an instant cold pack is not part of the first aid kit;

13. Sealable leak-proof plastic bags in assorted sizes or double bagged plastic bags that can be securely tied for materials soiled with blood or bodily fluids;

14. Pocket mask or face shield, appropriate; for all ages of children in care, for cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) administration;

- 15. Soap or waterless sanitizer (field trip or transporting away from the program only);
- 16. Bottled water (field trip or transporting away from the program only).

Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

# Domain: 05 Health & Safety

Rule: 5101:2-13-16 Medical, Dental, and General Emergency Requirements Code: The program is required to complete and document the required drills.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that the required drills were not completed for item numbers 2 and 3 below:

- 1. Monthly fire drills
- 2. Monthly weather emergency drills (March through September)
- 3. Quarterly emergency/lockdown drills.

Submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

## Rule: 5101:2-13-22 Meals and Snacks

Code: The program is required to post a current menu for the week.

Findings: During this inspection, it was observed that the current menu for this week was not posted. Correct the violation and submit the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-07 Provider Requirements

Code: The provider is required to maintain the required liability insurance or have a completed JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" on file for each child in care.

Findings: During the inspection, it was determined the provider did not obtain or maintain the required JFS 01933 "Liability Insurance Statement for Family Child Care Providers" completed for each child in care. Correct the violation and submit proof of insurance with the program's corrective action plan to verify compliance with the requirement of the rule.

Rule: 5101:2-13-15 Child's Medical

Code: The program is required to have a completed medical on file for each child.

Findings: In review of of the children's records, it was determined that completed medical statements were not on file, as required, for children listed on the JFS Children's Record Review For Child Care as indicated in number 2 below:

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child
- 2. Medical(s) on file was not updated every 13 months
- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for
- participation in group care

6. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified

- nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 7. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year

8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases

9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of

conscience, including religious convictions
