<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, required staff/child ratios were not maintained for [the same group/different groups] on multiple occasions, as noted below:

The ratio determined for the mixed age group was 13 Child Care Staff Member(s) for children. Additionally, a ratio of 1Child Care Staff Member(s) for 13 children was determined for the Lobe Bugs 2 group. age group.

Additional staff members must be hired or current Child Care Staff Members must be rescheduled to maintain compliance. Provide staff training. - 2. Child(ren) were left unattended more than once.
- 3. Child(ren) left the group and were unattended.
- 4. Child care staff were using a baby monitor to supervise children.
- 5. Child care staff were using a walkie talkie to supervise children.
- 6. Child care staff were using mirrors to view children in another room.
- 7. Child care staff were using a video camera instead of physically being present in the room.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined the program did not follow guidelines set forth by the Governor of Ohio or the Director of the Ohio Department of Health in that masks were not worn by school age

The group size shall not exceed twice the maximum number of children allowed per Child Care Staff Member. Submit the program's corrective action plan to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the Love Bugs group, which included children less than two and one-half years, were cared for in a space where a group of older children were receiving care. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-22 Fluid Milk Requirements

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to obtain parental consent to serve a child over 12 months of age a non-cow milk substitute.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no written parental consent to serve a child over twelve months of age a non-cow milk substitution. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that the current menu for this week was not posted. Code: The program staff is required to label bottles containing formula or breast milk.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that bottles containing milk for a particular infant were not labeled with the child's name and date of preparation. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

Rule: 5101:2-12-23 Infant Daily Care

<u>Code</u>: The program is required to provide a daily written record for each infant in care to the parents when picking up the infant each day.

<u>Finding</u>: During the inspection, it was determined that there was no daily written record for each infant provided to the parent or person picking up the infant on a daily basis. Technical assistance was provided at the time of the inspection, and as discussed, please correct this rule noncompliance. A written response for this rule noncompliance is not required at this time.

<u>Code</u>: The program staff medicals are required to be completed and on file at the program.

<u>Finding</u>: In review of the staff records, it was determined that completed medical examination statement(s) for the employee(s) listed on the Employee Record Chart was not on file, as required by this rule. Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a copy of the verification of a high school education, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 1. The JFS 01176 Program Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care the program received from the Department was not on file and the individual was not left alone with children.
- 2. The JFS 01177 Individual Notification of Background Check Review for Child Care was on file instead of the JFS 01176.
- 3. The JFS 01176 on file was for a different program.

Submit the program's corrective action plan, which includes a statement that the correct form is now on file, to the Department to verify compliance with the requirements of this rule.

- 1. No medical was on file for at least one child

- 3. Medical(s) were missing child's name and date of birth
- 4. Medical(s) were missing the date of the medical examination
- 5. Medical(s) were missing a statement that the child has been examined and is in suitable condition for participation in group care
- 6. Medical(s) were missing the signature, business address and telephone number of the physician, physician's assistant(PA), advance practice nurse (APN) or certified nurse practitioner (CNP) who examined the child
- 7. Medical(s) were missing a record of immunizations the child has had specifying month, day and year
- 8. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the physician, PA, APN, or CNP that the child has been immunized or is in the process of being immunized against the diseases required by division 5104.014 of the Revised Code and found in appendix A to this rule
- 9. Medical(s) were missing a statement from the child's parent or guardian that he or she has declined to have the child immunized against the disease for reasons of conscience, including religious convictions
