Findings: During the inspection, it was determined that hazardous conditions existed in the outdoor play area, as noted in number(s) 10 below:

- 1. There was broken glass.
- 2. There were tall weeds.
- 3. There was poison ivy.
- 4. There were tree branches.
- 5. There was mold visible.
- 6. There were thistles with prickers.
- 7. There were bird droppings.
- 8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
- 9. The sandbox was contaminated.

10. Other : A piece of the playground climbing equipment was broken. Program immediately submitted a request to have equipment repaired and children were not allowed to use the piece of equipment.
