1. There was broken glass.
2. There were tall weeds.
3. There was poison ivy.
4. There were tree branches.
5. There was mold visible.
6. There were thistles with prickles.
7. There were bird droppings.
8. There were bolts with more than two threads exposed along a fence line or gate on a playground.
9. The sandbox was contaminated.
10. Other : A piece of the playground climbing equipment was broken. Program immediately submitted a request to have equipment repaired and children were not allowed to use the piece of equipment.
